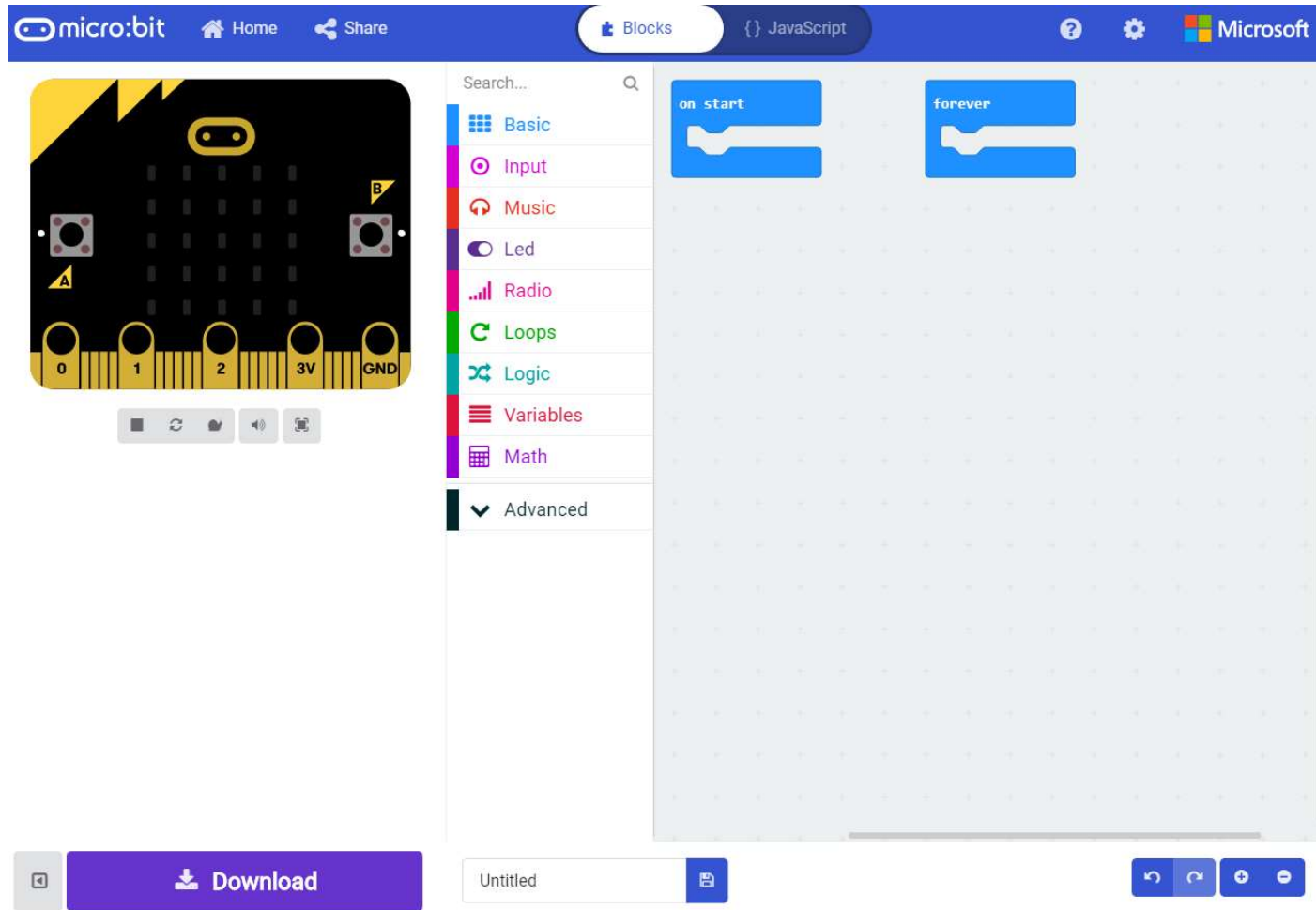


# Get started with coding on your microbit

Go to <https://makecode.microbit.org/#editor>

You will see a screen that looks like this:



This is **main editor window** where we will learn to code and test our code before we actually place it into the micro:bit

On the **left** is a virtual micro:bit which will execute your code on the simulator before you use a real micro:bit.

To the **right** of that is the section where we choose all of our various code blocks.

To the **right of that** is the coding area where we drag our blocks of code to fit into each other and create a program we can run.
